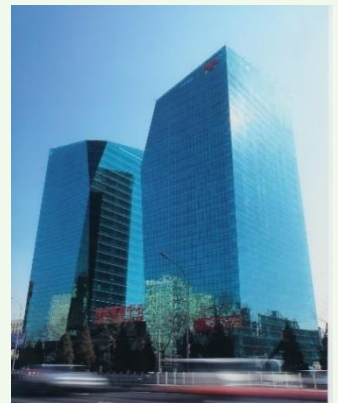
The successful candidate will have:
