The NSG Group is a global leader in glass manufacturing in three business areas: Architectural, Automotive and Creative Technology.

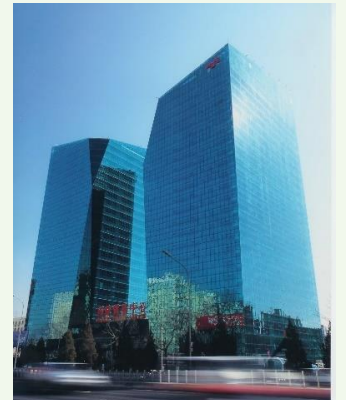
