
Our mission is to be the global leader in innovative highperformance glass and glazing solutions, working safely and ethically.

THE ROLE

An opportunity has arisen for a temporary role within the Processing and Testing Team, part of the Laminating, Processing and Manufacturing Group located at the NSG European Technical Centre. The team are responsible for the development and testing of new glass products for the architectural and automotive strategic business units. The role will have particular focus on the development of laminated products for the architectural market. The successful applicant will be expected to integrate into existing product development projects and contribute to the planning and execution of objectives to successfully bring products to market.

The role will involve responsibility for trial planning, sample manufacture and functional analysis of product performance along with creation of summary reports to support the project team. Specialist instruments and dedicated test equipment will be used, with full training to be provided where necessary. Process development and production trials on manufacturing sites may also be required, with travel for this typically one week or less in

duration. The successful candidate will also be expected to demonstrate a visible commitment to safety, quality, and ethical behaviour.
